A project funded by NHS England to support transformation across the health and social care system in our area for adults and young people with a learning disability or autism, to include the following:

- A programme of free Positive Behaviour Support (PBS) Training and coaching for people providing direct care, their supervisors, and senior managers, and those working for our local authorities or NHS (e.g., social workers, OTs, nurses).
- A review of multi-agency working to improve joined up working: Local Authorities, CCG, Providers, Dorset Healthcare's Intensive Support Team.

Our aim is to grow the ability of a wide range of people working in social care and health so those with complex behaviour needs are well supported and those working with them are confident about their skills to work safely.

With an able and confident workforce, and knowledgeable and supportive managers, we will be in a better position to support people to live successfully in the community leading lives that are meaningful to them.
